



2024 Grainger County 4-H Archery

Archery is a team where your child will learn confidence, teamwork, and marksmanship. 4-H Archery shoots Genesis, Compound, and Recurve division. We have Genesis bows here in the county that you may use. If you would like to shoot in the compound or recurve division please bring your own. These bows must follow the rules on the TN 4-H Shooting Sports website.

What is the time commitment for archery?

4-H Archery will begin practices on January 22 and will practice most Mondays until the Jamboree. The Archery Jamboree will be held on April 19-20 in Cookeville, TN at Hyder-Burke Ag Pavilion. This will be a great opportunity to meet archers across the state. Practice dates are as follows:

Archery practices will be at the following times: 5:15-6:00, 6:00-6:45, and 6:45-7:30. You will pick your time when you sign up. Parents/guardians will be expected to stay at the practice facility with their child until practice is over. This is to help us ensure that everyone is safe. Attendance at 8 of the 11 practices is REQUIRED to attend the Archery Jamboree. We encourage you to attend all of the practices if able.

What is the financial commitment for archery?

4-Her will pay an \$80 club fee by December 21 to join the team. This fee will cover the use of equipment, competition fees, and the cost of team jersey. Please note that the cost of attending the Jamboree will be covered by the 4-Her and their family. No late sign-ups will be accepted.

Where are practices for archery held?

Archery practices will be held at Rocky Meadows Farm & Recreation. The address for practices is 326 Milligan Lane Blaine, TN 37709.
